In previous years, the US Election has been celebrated with a large bipartisan gathering in the center of Brussels bringing together both the American and international community to participate in on-site discussions and debates while preparing for the election results. In this unprecedented year, the current pandemic restrictions will not enable us to gather in-person; however, this will not prevent us from still gathering and commemorating this historic event.

Open for free for the ACB membership community (and offered to the public for a small fee of 5 euros), we invite you to join us on Tuesday, November 3rd for a short evening of education, information and celebration of the great American democracy.

This bipartisan event will include several speakers regarding relations between the United States and Europe, debates between Democrats and Republicans and discussions on the difference between the economic and tax plans of each of the candidates. Speakers will discuss this historic election and the relationship between the US and Europe going forward.
